(d) Appointment of Clerk

Cllr Mills had reviewed and was content with the clerk's draft contract (based on the National Association of Local Councils model) but noted a numbering error and that the policies referred to needed to be provided. The Clerk to provide draft policies for the next meeting so that the contract may be considered.
